Enrolled in and successfully complete 12 program hours per semester

Priority given to KS residents; out-of-state students considered if funds allow



NJCAA ATHLETIC **AWARD VARIES**

Awarded Letter of Intent by coach
Must meet and abide by all NJCAA regulations, including GPA requirements
Must abide by any & all team rules
Scholarship amounts vary for all student athletes



SERVICE **\$1,350 PER SEMESTER** (\$2,700 PER ACADEMIC SCHOOL YEAR)

Must be a KS resident
Must complete the FASFA
Maintain college GPA of 2.0 or higher
Complete 60 hours of service



ACTIVITY **\$1,350 PER SEMESTER** (\$2,700 PER ACADEMIC SCHOOL YEAR)

Must be a KS resident
(out-of-state & international students are eligible to receive book award)
Maintain college GPA of 2.0 or higher
Abide by any & all activity rules



NURSING **AWARD VARIES**

Must be a KS resident
Must be accepted into Nursing Program
Award based on recommendation from the Director of Nursing
Enroll in a minimum of 7 NCCC nursing hours each semester
Provide letter stating financial need
Provide letter of recommendation from 2 general education and/or nursing faculty
Receive grade of 'C' or higher in all required courses

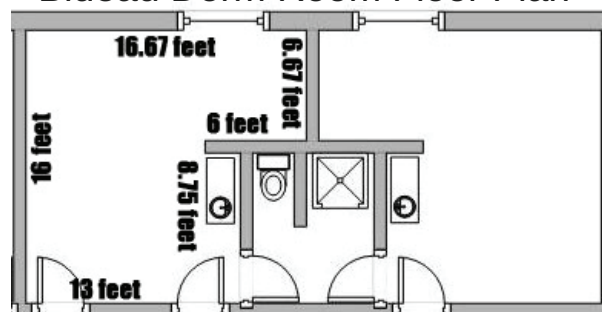


RESIDENCE LIFE

BIDEAU HALL

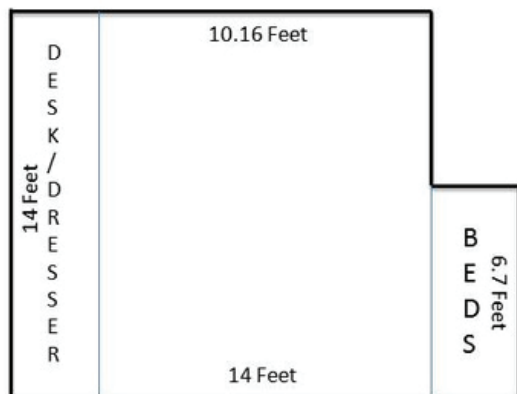
- Co-Ed Residence Hall for 213 Students

- Each room has 2-3 XL twin beds, dressers, desks, desk chairs
- Free (for residents only) laundry room in each hallway
- Lobby equipped with TV, couches, Ping Pong table, computers with free printing
- Movie room on 2nd floor with flat screen TV, Internet access, and DVD player
- Game room with 7 stations
- Vending machines on 1st floor
- Amenities available 24/7 to all on-campus students
