<u>Purchasing or Reservations</u> - Course materials are typically available within two (2) weeks of the beginning of any class. Like any other online venue, create an account by registering your account as a 'buyer', selecting the 'Textbooks' tab, then clicking the drop-down menu to find the course and section you are enrolled in. Course materials, including Rental Books, can either be shipped to you (at the cost of the student) or be reserved for later pickup at either the Chanute or Ottawa campus.

<u>Payment</u> - The website will process credit/debit cards for charges. If you are choosing to pay for books using the Scholarship, Financial Aid, or Pell Grant option, you will be notified via email when verification has been made and purchases can be processed.
